A Step-by-Step Guide to the Application of ZIPZOC Zinc Oxide Medicated Stocking

- 1. Assess the length and size of the limb to be dressed and cut the stocking to size, remembering that when the stocking is stretched laterally, it will shorten slightly. Alternatively, if the stocking is too long, the excess may be simply folded back on itself rather than cutting away.
- 2. To apply, simply roll the stocking up onto the limb in a similar way to applying a sock. The stocking may be applied in direct contact with the skin or wound.
- **3.** Pull up towards the knee area and smooth away any wrinkles or folds before covering with a retention bandage, garment, or compression therapy system*.
- **4.** To remove **ZIPZOC**, roll away down the limb, discard and re-apply a new sterile **ZIPZOC** stocking.
 - *Compression therapy systems should only be applied on the advice of a clinician following thorough assessment.

NOTE

ZIPZOC may be used in other parts of the body, e.g. on an upper limb to treat skin conditions. Cut the stocking to size, apply to the affected area and cover with a retention bandage or garment.
